# Women's and Girls' Officer Role

We are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic person to work as part of the Foundation team and lead on the development of the Women's and Girls' offer within the Foundation.

Bath City Foundation has a tradition of providing opportunities for women and girls of all ages and abilities to participate in grassroots football.

The Women's and Girls' Officer will support the Foundation's football offering for all girls and women across Bath and BANES. The successful candidate will be responsible for supporting the development of our Girls' & Women's Football programmes. In addition to this, the Officer will also coach & lead delivery on a number of our key girls' Football Programmes.

This post will strengthen our existing offer through providing high-quality football coaching and playing pathways for all women and girls in our area.

The postholder will work in partnership with other partners eg, Bath City FC, Somerset FA, schools etc, within BANEs to identify areas of greatest need and work together to develop pathways to enable women and girls to participate and enjoy playing football whatever their age or their ability.

#### Salary: £20,000 - £22,000 depending on experience

Time commitment: Full-time (37.5 hours) based at home or Twerton Park. These days and hours are flexible depending on the sessions running.

Fixed Term: for 2 years

- To support in organising and delivering effective training and fixture programmes
- To support in developing and delivering an effective recruitment strategy
- To support in working to achieve the budget set
- To act as a role model for all female players and potential future coaches
- To continue to develop all programmes within the girls' football remit
- To work and support the Foundation programme as a whole

- To lead on all Foundation Women's & Girls' programme delivery.
- To support the day-to-day organising and development of all the Foundation's girls' programmes

- To develop key working relationships with the Foundation's partners
- To support and work towards achieving budget targets which have been set and agreed with the Project Manager.
- To build relationships with all partners and beneficiaries within the programme
